

MEDICAL TREATMENT LOG

The purpose of this log is to keep a permanent record of all medicine dispensed during the course of a 4-H event or activity. All medical treatment should be administered within the Safety Guidelines set forth by Georgia 4-H program and within the training and certification of the caregiver.

As a reminder, over-the-counter medication may be given to a youth if:

- A) A medical professional recommends the medication.
- B) The 4-H Medical Information and Release Form indicates it may be given.
- C) A parent/guardian is contacted and verbal consent is given to administer.

Note:

“Administered by” indicates the person who treated the 4-H'er. (This may be more than one person.)

“How was permission obtained?” must be completed with the one of the following: “Medical Information and Release Form (MIRF),” “medical professional prescribed,” or “phone call to parent/guardian.”
