<p>Other Activities 10 Points Participation in county, district, region or state events, judging teams not related to the main project and awards and recognition may be included</p>					
<p>State Congress ONLY Interview 15 Points Includes confidence, clarity, creativity and general appearance as shown during State Congress interview</p>
